

Equality Profile Data Report for South Lincolnshire

The Greater East Midlands Commissioning Support unit (GEMCSU) Equality Inclusion and Human Rights Team (EIHR team) have prepared the following tables using the data collected in the 2011 census. This table illustrates the profile of the area served by each of the four Lincolnshire CCGs against the following protected characteristics:

- Age
- Gender
- Disability
- Ethnicity
- Religion

Lincolnshire is a large county in the east of England, bordering Norfolk to the south east, Cambridgeshire to the south, Rutland to the south west, Leicestershire and Nottinghamshire to the west, South Yorkshire to the northwest, and the East Riding of Yorkshire to the north.

The County's total population was identified as 713,653 in the 2011 Census. This population is distributed across a large number of rural localities and a few urban centres. Lincoln, the County town, is the largest urban centre with a population of 119,541 recorded in the 2011 census. The towns of Grimsby (88,243) and Scunthorpe (79,977) form the second and third largest population centres in company with the other smaller towns within Lincolnshire.

The diversity of the County's population has increased in recent years as a result of new and emerging communities. As of the 2011 Census, 93% of residents identify themselves as White British with a significant 4% identifying as White Other. This 4% is primarily made of Eastern European communities. The age profile and other characteristics are closer to the average for similar Shire counties.

The CCG's population demographics demonstrate broad parity with those of the rest of Lincolnshire. This was counted as 140286 persons in the 2011 census, making this CCG one of the two smaller CCGs in Lincolnshire by population served.

Within the population demographic a higher proportion of people have identified as "White other" (5.41%) illustrating the presence of emerging Eastern European communities within the CCG's area.
