Decision to be made on long-term future of GP services for former Pennygate patients

You recently attended one of the public engagement events regarding the longer-term access to GP services for patients formerly registered at Pennygate Health Centre. The online survey closed on 31st December and this information has been evaluated together with the feedback we heard at the events.

All of the feedback will be considered by the CCG's Primary Care Commissioning Committee, who will make a decision as to the future provision of GP services, which will also be considered by the CCG's Governing Body that will meet later the same day (Thursday 31 January).

Both the Primary Care Commissioning Committee and Governing Body meetings will be held on Thursday 31 January 2019, at the Springfields Events Centre, Spalding – the Primary Care Commissioning Committee will meet at 10.30 am and the Governing Body will meet at 2.30pm. Both meetings are held in public but are not public meetings – members of the public are welcome to attend and observe but cannot ask questions – for more details see the CCG's website www.southlincolnshireccg.nhs.uk.

Following the decision being made regarding long-term future of GP services it is our intention to write to all former Pennygate patients to inform them of our plans.
